From the North: I-35 south to CR-2 exit, EXIT 131, toward US-8/FOREST LAKE. Turn RIGHT onto W BROADWAY AVE/CR-2 W and go 6.9 miles. Turn LEFT onto LEXINGTON AVE NE/CR-17/CR-18 and continue for 4.8 miles. Turn RIGHT onto BUNKER LAKE BLVD NE/CR-116 W, for 3.5 miles. Turn RIGHT onto ABERDEEN ST NE for 1 block. Facility is on the right.

From the South: I-35W north. Merge onto US-10 W via EXIT 30 toward ANOKA for 2.8 miles. EXIT on HWY 65 (Central Ave) and turn RIGHT traveling for 6.1 miles. Turn RIGHT at BUNKER LAKE BLVD. Turn LEFT on ABERDEEN ST. NE for 1 block. Facility is on the right.

From the East: Take I-94 to I-35W NORTH. Merge onto US-10 W via EXIT 30 toward ANOKA for 2.8 miles. EXIT on HWY 65 (Central Ave) and turn RIGHT traveling for 6.1 miles. Turn RIGHT at BUNKER LAKE BLVD. Turn LEFT on ABERDEEN ST. NE for 1 block. Facility is on the right.

Simplified jump height process

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section on top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box IF YOUR DOG NEEDS TO BE MEASURED so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs to be Measured List*. **It is no longer required to submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or to show it during day of show check-in.**

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This Trial is open to all dogs **fifteen (15)** months of age or older that are registered with the AKC or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing or Indefinite Listing Privilege (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Dogs or registerable breeds with accepted foreign registration numbers are eligible to participate. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

After closing wait list:

A waiting list (20 run maximum per day) will be maintained for these trials once they have closed on April 10th. The waiting list will be active until its deadline, Friday, April 19th, 6pm. Any dogs that are entered in these trials at closing and pulled before the waiting list deadline will be replaced, if possible, by dogs in order on the waiting list and the exhibitor will be reimbursed in full. **If a dog is pulled but cannot be replaced, the exhibitor will not receive a refund (unless the dog is injured or in season and has supplied a vet note) and the dog will be considered absent.** Entry fees for dogs on the waiting list that do not get into the trial by the waiting list closing date will be refunded in full. NOTE: Dogs from the waiting list may not appear in the exhibitor's catalog due to the late closing date.

Entry is not valid unless on official version of entry form approved by AKC. Entry is not valid without the agreement page accompanying the entry form!! Please read and sign the agreement section and return with entry form.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

NOTICES TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that the dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. CMKC and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

CMKC reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against CMKC or any official thereof.

Puppies under the age of 4 months are strictly prohibited from the site.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in ring or in the designated agility warm-up area. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

Entries - Refunds – Fees - Payments

Entry Fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from the competition by action of the Trial Committee. The fees will be refunded for entries withdrawn before closing date. The fees will be refunded minus a \$12.00 fee per day for dogs injured after the closing date and bitches in season after the closing date if a veterinarian certificate is presented to the Trial Secretary prior to first scheduled run. No refunds for duplicate entries.

No entry fee will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Make checks and money orders payable to CMKC. Canadian exhibitors make fees payable in US\$.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$20.00 service charge for any returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging. If they must be measured, then they must arrive prior to the start of their class. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Crates may be left overnight; however CMKC and On The Run Canine Center will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

Crating space is limited. NO EX PENS.

Please help preserve the matting by wearing clean athletic shoes. The mats have a lot of “grip”, so turf shoes are not recommended. No spike shoes and no FIRM GRIP or other sticky spray on the dogs’ paws. Anyone witnessed using sticky spray on his/her dog may be excused from the trial weekend with no monies refunded.

Food will NOT be available on site. Lunch will be provided for workers. There are various restaurants and fast food vendors within a very short driving distance.

No overnight parking will be allowed at the trial site. No electrical hook-ups for motor homes or campers are available.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

A New Title rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title. A MACH/PACH rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their MACH/PACH.

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
